In response to your request for information on Bill Hosack's creations I offer the following:

The structure you refer to as a "smokehouse" was constructed by Mr. Hosack to work in and to house his creations. It never was or intended to be a smokehouse. The small hut-like building was behind his residence and was obviously a studio and was itself part of his creative output. This structure was demolished several years ago.

Some pieces of Hosack's work were taken from the hut and are in the museum's collection. They were in poor condition when we got them and have not improved since.
